


## LAND MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT







## The faculty was founded in 1958. Research Areas:

-development of scientific and methodical recommendations in areas of land use, rural resettlement, land use planning and management of land valuation in market conditions;

-formation of the economic mechanism of turnover of land in the country;

-land management, inventory and assessment of property and land.

The following results have been achieved for 2009-2012.:

- recommendations for sizing agricultural enterprises to ensure their competitiveness were developed;
- researches on land management as a factor in increasing the competitiveness of agricultural production (landscape-ecological approach and certification of land in land management) were conducted.
- -temporary methodical instructions on the organization and conduct monitoring of arable land (organization of the territory on the basis of ecological and landscape) were developed.

- theoretical and practical aspects of land cadastre;
- evaluation of land and property;
- management of land resources;
- on improving the competitiveness of the regional economy of Kazakhstan in terms of financial instability: the factors, trends and mechanisms;

- Improving land cadastre based on the Land Code of the Republic of Kazakhstan;
- economic foundations of the formation of land use (peasant) farms;
- The theory and practice of organizational and technological transformation of the land use system of Kazakhstan;
- -The development of scientific and methodological basis of improving the system of land use and land tenure, land relations, the organization of rational use and protection of agricultural land for the creation of a land market, based on the inventory and valuation of the land;
- -The development of the methodology and techniques of cadastral valuation of agricultural land and land settlements based on the zoning and use of materials  $\dots$
